

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 18BON29 MFR - Pacific Lamprey mortalities in CRITFC pot traps and holding tanks at Bonneville and John Day Dams.

6/12 – 1 found dead in trap at Bradford Island (BFI).

6/18 – 1 fish from Bonneville Dam (BON) found dead in John Day Dam (JDD) holding tank. From trapping either 6/16, 6/17, or 6/18.

6/20 – 2 fish from traps at BON (unsure, likely BFI).

6/22 – 1 BON fish. Found dead in JDD holding tank.

6/23 – 1 BFI trap #4. Found weak in trap and was planned to be rejected, died in tote before release.

6/24 – 2 fish from traps #3 and #4 at BFI.

6/25 – 1 dead in trap at BFI #4.

6/25 – 1 dead in JDD tank, BON fish.

6/26 – 1 dead in trap #4 at BFI. @AFF

6/27 – 1 found in BFI trap #4. 1 found in JDD green tank during YN transfer. Fish from yesterday's catch at JDD. 1 found in JDD silver tank during YN transfer. From yesterday's catch from BON. Fish had mostly dark coloring throughout the top side of its body, but with a white/pale line over its gill holes.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Wild.
- C. Length – Measured. Not included within this MFR but available by request
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Cause unknown.

G. Future and Preventative Measures – None at this time.
