

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 18BON49 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Pacific Lamprey Mortality.**

On the morning of 20 July, University of Idaho technicians contacted Project Fisheries to alert them of (1) Pacific Lamprey mortality. The fish was tagged on the morning of 19 July. The fish was reported to have eyes that appeared cloudy, but seemed in good health otherwise. After tagging, it was observed to be in poor condition and was not released. The fish was found dead in its holding tank on the morning of 20 July.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Wild
- C. Length – 73 cm
- D. Marks and tags – A tag was implanted, but then removed after mortality.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Night of 19-20 July.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
