

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 18BON58 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Chinook Mortality.**

On 05 September, CRITFC researchers found a Chinook mortality on the North side of the deck near the collection pool. It was possibly attracted by a small external water source that drained into the collection pool from the lamprey holding /work area. The fish was frozen for analysis.

- A. Species – Chinook (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Wild/unclipped.
- C. Length – 90 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – No tags.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Bleeding and bruising from flopping around.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Between 1100 and 1300.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Prevent external water sources from entering collection pool.
