

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 19BON08 Adult Fish Facility (AFF) Chinook Salmon Mortality.

On the morning of 10 June, CRITFC researchers informed Project Fisheries of a Chinook Salmon mortality in the brail pool at the AFF. The fish had not previously been sampled. Due to its coloration, it likely came in sometime the previous day (Sunday).

After sampling, the fish was returned to the river.

1. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
2. Origin – Unknown, adipose present.
3. Length – Approximately 71 cm.
4. Marks and tags – No marks/and or tags observed. No PIT present.
5. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Marine mammal mark near the caudal peduncle. See photos.
6. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
7. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
