**SUBJECT: 19BON30 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Pacific Lamprey Mortalities**

On the morning of 09 July, U of I technicians found a Pacific Lamprey mortality in a holding tank. The fish was tagged on 08 July and held to be used in a flume trial (was not used in flume trial). It had clear eyes and a slightly red mouth. Photos were taken after 45 minutes in a freezer.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – Approximately 66.5 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – 3D6.1D5957768B.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Slight red mouth.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
