**SUBJECT: 19BON40 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Pacific Lamprey and Chinook Mortalities**

On the morning of 22 July, CRITFC technicians found (3) Pacific Lamprey and (1) Chinook salmon mortalities on the valve 15 trash rack. The fish were scanned for PIT tags (none read), inspected for marks and/or injuries, and returned to the river. Information collected is found below.

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unknown, adipose present.
- C. Length – Approximately 22 cm.
