

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

SUBJECT: 19BON42 MFR – Adult Fish Facility Pacific Lamprey and Sockeye Salmon Mortalities.

On the morning of 24 July, CRITFC technicians found a Pacific Lamprey and a Sockeye Salmon mortalities on the valve 15 trash rack. The fish were scanned for PIT tags (none read), inspected for marks and/or injuries, and returned to the river. Information collected is found below.

- C. Length – Approximately 39 cm.
