

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 20BON100 Adult Fish Facility Chinook Mortality**

On Tuesday, October 6th, CRITFC Biologists notified Project Biologists of an adult chinook mortality found on the valve 15 trash rack in the AFF. The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river. There was a large gash and herniation from behind the fish's anal fin and a smaller one from behind its gill plate.

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – Approximately 81.3 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – PIT 3DD.003D6316B2
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – laceration and herniation behind anal fin and gill plate
- F. Cause and Time of Death – unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
