

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 20BON19 MFR – Juvenile Salmonid Morts in Unit 8 Salvage.**

On 16 and 17 June, project biologists salvaged several hundred fish from Bonneville's unit 8 scroll case and draft tube. Two mortalities were observed. One was accidentally stepped on in the scroll case, the other was found as a floater in the holding tank upon transport. The condition of the floater was noted as poor (skinny), but no photo was taken in the interest of releasing the other fish as fast as possible. Tank temp had been holding steady and oxygen was being supplied to the water. The squished fish is below with a glove to show the size.

- A. Species – Salmonids (*Oncorhynchus*).
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – ~8-12 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – PIT tags: not checked
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – The floater was noted as being skinny and in poor condition.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Both during salvage operations.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
