

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 20BON40 MFR – Powerhouse 2 Unit 13 Draft Tube Mortalities.**

On 14 July, Project Fisheries recovered one juvenile Steelhead mortality and had one juvenile Chinook mortality resulting from fish salvage efforts in the unit 13 draft tube. The Steelhead was in rough shape and missing a lot of scales. The Chinook was in good shape and likely died due to the stress of handling. They were returned to the river.

- A. Species – Chinook (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*).
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – Approximately 8 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Handling stress at Approximately 1030, 14 July
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Given the nature of draft tube salvages, there is nothing reasonable to be done differently.
  
- H. Species – Steelhead (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*).
- I. Origin – Unknown
- J. Length – Approximately 18 cm.
- K. Marks and tags – None
- L. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Significant descaling
- M. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- N. Future and Preventative Measures – None
