

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 20BON42 CRITFC BI Tube Trap Pacific Lamprey Mortality

On Tuesday morning 7/14/2020, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in a tube trap deployed in the Bradford Island Fish Ladder AWS. The fish was collected for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program. The cause of death was not apparent, but abrasions and a wound were visible on the individual. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the trap and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- C. Length – 61.6 cm
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – abrasions, one circular wound/injury
