

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 20BON47 CRITFC AFF Holding Tank Pacific Lamprey Mortality

On Wednesday morning 7/15/2020, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in one of the AFF holding tanks. The fish was collected at Bonneville Dam on 7/14 for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program and was slated for delivery to Nez Perce staff on 7/15. No obvious cause of death was observed, the oral disc had minor hemorrhaging. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the tank and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- C. Length – 24.5”
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – minor oral disc bleeding
- F. Cause and Time of Death – unknown
