

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 20BON58 CRITFC Tube Trap Pacific Lamprey Mortality

On Wednesday morning 7/22/2020 CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in a tube trap deployed in the Bradford Island Fish Ladder AWS. The fish was collected for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program. The cause of death is not known but moderate hemorrhaging around the oral disc was present. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the trap and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – oral disc hemorrhaging
