

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD****SUBJECT: 20BON61 CRITFC Tube Trap Pacific Lamprey Mortality**

On Friday morning 7/24/2020, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in a tube trap deployed in the Bradford Island Fish Ladder AWS. The fish was collected for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program. The cause of death is not known, however the individual had pale white ventral area often found on mortalities and rejected fish. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the trap and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.
