

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 20BON64 CRITFC AFF Holding Tank Pacific Lamprey Mortalities**

On Monday morning 7/27/2020, CRITFC staff found two Pacific Lamprey mortalities in one of the AFF holding tanks. The fish were collected at Bonneville Dam on 7/25 and 7/26 for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program and were slated for delivery to CTUIR staff on 7/27. No obvious cause of death was observed, one fish had numerous marks and abrasions. Photos were taken at the time of removal from the tank and are attached. The individuals were frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- C. Length – 576 mm, 635 mm
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – abrasions
- F. Cause and Time of Death – unknown
