

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD****SUBJECT: 20BON68 Adult Fish Facility Steelhead Mortality.**

In the morning of Thursday, July 30<sup>th</sup>, CRITFC biologists notified Project Biologists of a Steelhead mortality found on the valve 15 trash rack of the AFF. The fish was scanned for PIT tags and inspected for any abnormal injuries. The fish was tagged for CRITFC by ODFW on Monday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. The fish was in great condition when it was tagged and was only the 3<sup>rd</sup> fish they tagged Monday so it was in a fresh tank of water and the water temp was 19.5 degrees C. There were no visible injuries and the tag insertion point appears to be clean (see picture). The fish was bagged, labeled and placed in the freezer.

- A. Species – Steelhead (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*)
- B. Origin – Unknown but was tagged on Monday, July 27<sup>th</sup> for CRITFC by ODFW
- C. Length – Approximately 66 cm
- D. Marks and tags – PIT ID: 3DD.003D53ADE1
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
