

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 20BON76 Adult Fish Facility Chinook Mortality.

On Tuesday, August 4th, CRITFC biologists notified Project Biologists of a juvenile Chinook mortality found on the valve 15 trash rack of the AFF. The fish was scanned for PIT tags and inspected for any abnormal injuries. Upon inspection, a medium sized laceration was found on its dorsal side just behind the dorsal fin and there was noticeable swelling and redness at the base of the anal fin.

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – Unknown.
- C. Length – Approximately 24 cm.
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Medium sized laceration along left side behind pectoral fin and swelling/redness on the anal fin
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.
