

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 21BON037 MFR Bradford Island Fishway Serpentine Sockeye Mortality**

In the morning of 07 July, Bonneville Project Biologists found a dead sockeye on the catwalk along the Bradford Island fishway serpentine. The plastic fence surrounding the catwalk installed to prevent fish from jumping into this area was inspected for holes. No holes were found in the fence. The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- D. Marks and tags – adipose not clipped, no tag
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – the fish was found dried out and already had been fed on by other animals.
