

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD****SUBJECT: 21BON038 MFR BI-AWS Tube Trap PL Mort**

On Tuesday morning 06 July, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in one of the tube traps deployed in the Bradford Island Auxiliary Water Supply (BI-AWS). The fish was slated for delivery to Nez Perce staff on 07 July. No obvious cause of death was observed, the fish showed some hemorrhaging on the oral disc. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the tank and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – Approximately 66 cm
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – oral disc hemorrhaging
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
