

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 21BON042 Adult Fish Facility MFR Smolt Chinook and Sockeye Mortalities**

In the morning of 09 July, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Project Fisheries of 1 smolt Chinook and 1 adult sockeye found on the valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river. The sockeye had a tag and had been sampled and tagged by CRITFC on 07 July.

- B. Origin – AFF Brail Pool
- C. Length – Approximately 51.3 cm
- D. Marks and tags – adipose not clipped, PIT# 3DD.003D8294A9
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none
- F. Cause and Time of Death – sometime between 07 and 09 July
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Cooler recovery tank temperatures
