

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 21BON043 MFR AFF Holding Tank PL Mort**

On the morning of 09 July, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in one of the Adult Fish Facility (AFF) holding tanks. The fish was collected at Bonneville Dam on 08 July for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program and was slated for delivery to Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation staff on 09 July. No obvious cause of death was observed, hemorrhaging from a small wound was present on the oral disc. Photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the tank and are attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.

- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – bloody wound on oral disc
