

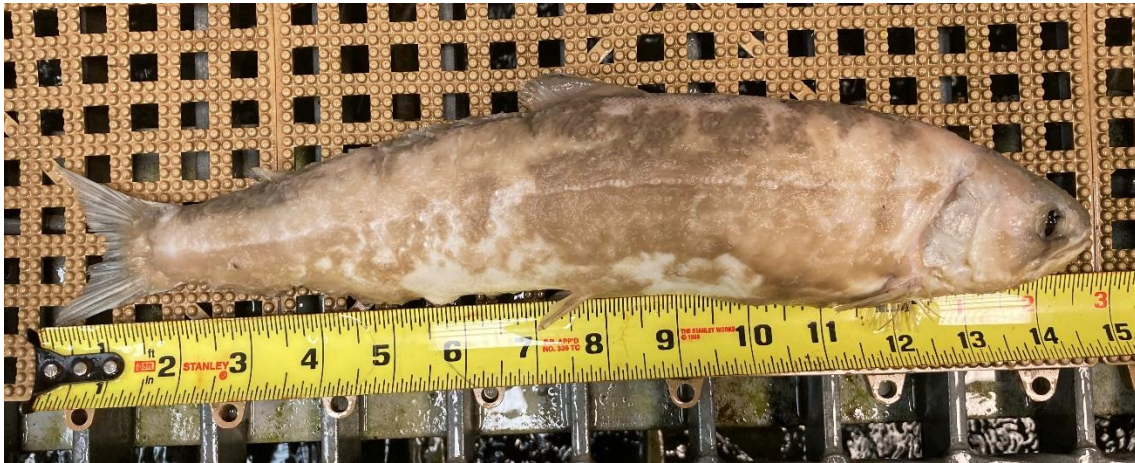
MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 21BON051 Adult Fish Facility Sockeye and Chinook Smolt Mortality

On the morning of 13 July, CRITFC biologists notified Project Biologists of one Sockeye and one Chinook smolt mortality found on the valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – Sockeye (*Oncorhynchus nerka*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – Approximately 37.5 cm
- D. Marks and tags – Not clipped, no tag
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None, very decayed
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None.

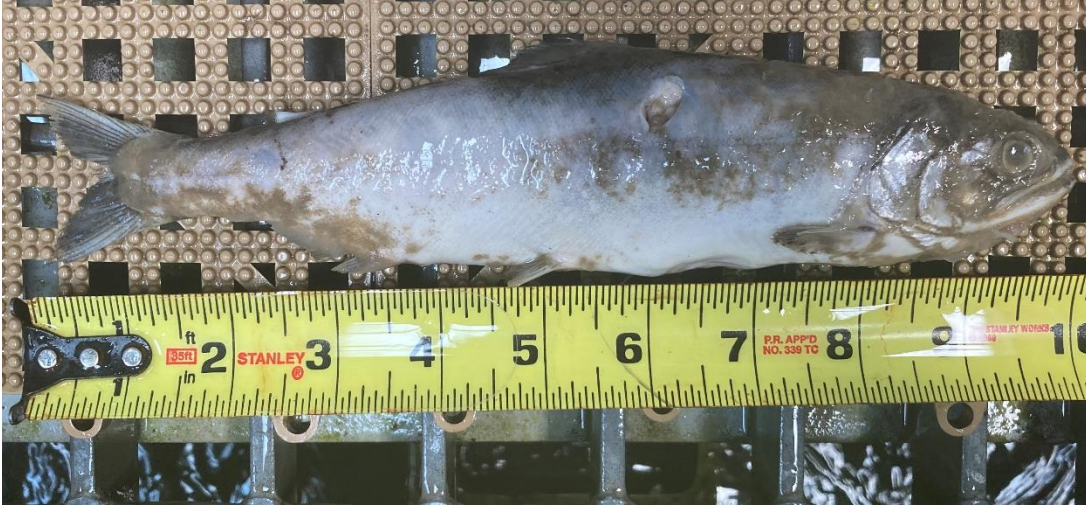
