In the morning of 15 July, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Project Fisheries of one adult sockeye and one adult Pacific Lamprey mortality found on the valve 15 trash rack in the AFF (Adult Fish Facility). The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.
