**SUBJECT: 21BON073 MFR Adult Fish Facility Chinook Smolt, Pacific Lamprey, and Steelhead Mortalities.**

On the morning of 30 July, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Project Fisheries of one Chinook smolt, one Pacific Lamprey, and one adult steelhead mortalities found on the valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.
