21BON078 MFR Pacific Lamprey AFF Holding Tank Mortality

On the morning of 22 August, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in one of the AFF holding tanks. The fish was collected at Bonneville Dam on 21 August for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program and was slated for delivery to the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation staff on 23 August. No obvious cause of death was observed, a photo of the fresh mortality was taken at the time of removal from the tank and is attached. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.
