SUBJECT: 21BON083 MFR AFF Valve 15 Trash Rack Coho Mortality

On the morning of 03 September, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Fisheries of one adult Coho Salmon discovered on the valve 15 trash rack of the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – Coho Salmon (*Oncorhynchus kisutch*)
- B. Origin – mark site: Willard National Fish Hatchery (WILL), release site: Coulter Creek Acclimation Pond Wenatchee River Basin (COULTP). Info retrieved from PTAGIS.
- C. Length – 69.2 cm
- D. Marks and tags – unclipped, PIT # 3DD.003D2B3ABC
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown cause of death. Time of death is sometime between 31 August when it was first detected in the AFF and 03 September when it was discovered on the trash rack.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – none
