SUBJECT: 21BON085 MFR Washington Shore Tube Trap PL Mortality

On Tuesday morning 07 September 2021, CRITFC staff found one Pacific Lamprey mortality in one of the Washington Shore tube traps. The fish was collected at Bonneville Dam on 07 September for the CRITFC-Tribal translocation program and was slated for delivery to Nez Perce Tribe staff on 10 September. The cause of death is unknown, photos of the fresh mortality were taken at the time of removal from the trap. The individual was frozen for potential future pathogen evaluation.
