

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 21BON088 MFR AFF Chinook Mortality**

On the morning of 10 September, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Fisheries of one Chinook Salmon discovered on the floor under the flumes in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish apparently decided to take a swan dive from the top of the flume a day or two previously. Due to advanced decay, no other injuries were able to be found. The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – Chinook Salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 54.4 cm
- D. Marks and tags – Not clipped, no PIT tag
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none other than decomposition
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Jumped from the flume a day or two previously
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – none
