

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD****SUBJECT: 21BON093 MFR AFF Chinook and PL mortalities**

On the morning of 23 September, CRITFC biologists notified Bonneville Fisheries of one pacific lamprey mortality discovered on the valve 15 trash rack of the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). They also found one Chinook Salmon that had jumped from the flume leading to the sample tank in previous days. The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- D. Marks and tags – Unclipped, no PIT tags
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – too decayed
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Jumped from flume to floor of AFF
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – in the process of fixing rubber flume flaps
