

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 21BON094 MFR AFF Chinook Mortality**

On the morning of 04 October, Bonneville Fisheries discovered one Chinook salmon mortality in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish had jumped from the sampling flumes on to the floor. The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – *Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*.
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 60 cm
- D. Marks and tags – Unclipped, no PIT tags
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Jumped out of sampling flume, time unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Work is underway to repair flume covers. Until work is completed, researchers have been instructed to turn off the sampling flumes if they do not have someone present on the sorting bridge.
