SUBJECT: 22BON047 MFR WA Shore UMTJ RB1 LPS Pacific Lamprey Mortality

On the morning of 17 July, Project Biologists discovered one adult Pacific Lamprey mortality in Rest Box 1 of the Washington shore Upstream Migrant Tunnel Junction (UMTJ RB1). The fish was scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – Approximately 71.1 cm
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Oral disk hemorrhaging
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
