SUBJECT: 22BON058 MFR AFF Lamprey and Sockeye Mortalities

On the morning of 21 July, Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission (CRITFC) notified Project Fisheries of six fish mortalities discovered on the valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The mortalities were composed of 5 adult Pacific Lampreys (Photo 1) and one adult sockeye (Photo 2). The fish were inspected, scanned, measured, and returned to the river.


