SUBJECT: 23BON022 MFR PH1 ITS auto gates closed

Discussion

On 17 May, a swimmer upstream of BON was lost in the river. Rescuers could not locate the swimmer. A tracking buoy was deployed in the last known location and tracked to PH1.

At 1700 on 17 May, BON closed the PH1 ITS auto gates and cleaned the trashrack in 1A but left the gate open.

As of noon on 18 May, the search continues. The ITS will remain with only 1A open until further notice.

Update – At 1000 on 22 May, the ITS autogates were returned to FPP criteria.
