**SUBJECT: 23BON045 MFR AFF Valve 15 PL and CH morts**

On the morning of 06 July, Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission (CRITFC) Biologists notified Bonneville Project Biologists of three Pacific Lamprey mortalities and on juvenile Chinook salmon found on the Valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF).

The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.
