

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**SUBJECT: 23BON071 MFR AFF Valve 15 Pacific Lamprey and Juvenile Chinook Mortalities**

On the morning of 31 July, Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission (CRITFC) Biologists notified Bonneville Project Biologists of five Pacific Lamprey mortalities and two adult Chinook salmon found on the Valve 15 trash rack in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The fish were scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.
