SUBJECT: 24BON028 MFR WA Shore UMTJ RB2 Pacific Lamprey Mortality

On the morning of 14 July 2024, Project Biologists discovered one adult Pacific Lamprey mortality in Rest Box 1 of the Washington Shore Upstream Migrant Transportation Junction LPS (WA Shore UMTJ LPS RB2). The fish was measured, scanned for PIT tags, inspected, and returned to the river.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entospehnus tridentatus*)
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 65.41cm
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – Some bleeding from orifices, but no visible injuries
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – N/A
