

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13JDA06 Adult Chinook mortality

On 14 September JDA personnel found a small adult Chinook, approximately 7-8 lbs, on the ground, beneath the JDA-S fishway. The fish jumped out of the fishway channel above and died falling down from the high elevation of approximately 50 feet. It is normal to see one or two adult salmonids jumping out of this ladder, at the same location per year; this is our first fish there this year.



- A. Species – Adult Chinook
- B. Origin – NA
- C. Length – 7- 8 lbs, small size
- D. Marks and tags – NA
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – NA, fish severely decomposed when found.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – jumped out of JD South Fishway, falling down to the ground from a high elevation approximately 4 to 5 days before it was found on 14 September.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – None currently known.
