SUBJECT: 14JDA10 MFR Pacific Lamprey Mortality at Smolt Monitoring Facility

On 17 July 2014, JDA Project biologist's found a Pacific Lamprey next to the return to river flume downstream of the head tank behind the Smolt Monitoring Facility. The Lamprey may have escaped from the holding tank used by Tribal fisheries which is located <20 feet away. Preventive measures are taken to reduce the likelihood of this happening by securing the lid shut.

- B. Origin – unknown
- C. Length – 570 mm
- D. Marks and tags – none
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – none
- F. Cause and Time of Death – PM 16 July – AM 17 July
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – secure the lid better.
