

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT:14JDA14 One Adult Chinook Salmon Mortality found the JDA South Fishway.**

- A. Species – One Adult Chinook Salmon, the adipose fin present.
- B. Origin – Unknown
- C. Length – 33 inches long
- D. Marks and tags – None
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None.
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Found on the JDA-S walkway on 18 September, at 1200 hrs, in fresh-dead condition. It appears that the fish jumped out of the fishway and landed on its walkway, on the other side of 4 feet high handrail.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Such morts are very infrequent, but they do occur occasionally, in different sections of both JDA fishways, this time of year. The total number of morts found next/adjacent to the JDA fishway channels is on average 2 to 3 fish per year and there are no known preventive measures.
