MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 17JDA04 MFR – One dead Adult Steelhead found on the PH tailrace deck, next to spillway # 20.

PROBLEM:

On April 7th, 2017 at approximately 18:00 JD Fisheries was notified by Security, of a dead steelhead on the PH tailrace deck, next to spillbay 20. The fish appears to have come from spillbay 20, which is currently discharging a high volume of turbulent flows. JD Fisheries inspects this area at least twice per day, so we are confident that the fish was there for a short time (1-3 hrs) before it was found. We don't recall any adult salmon mortalities there in the past.

Information collected is provided below:

- A. Species adult female steelhead
- B. Origin unknown
- C. Length approximately 85cm
- D. Marks and tags Adipose fin present, no marks or tags
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass fish in good condition, without any visible marks or injuries on the body.
- F. Cause and Time of Death Asphyxiation due to stranding on deck
- G. Future and Preventative Measures No known preventive measures exist.
