

**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: 17JDA11 MFR** - Pacific Lamprey mortalities in holding tanks behind the Smolt Monitoring Facility.

On Friday morning (7/2), the CRITFC collection crew found 3 (three) dead adult lamprey in the lamprey holding tank at John Day Dam behind the Smolt Monitoring Facility. These fish were collected the previous day from lamprey traps behind the picketed leads at The Dalles Dam or John Day Dam and held overnight at the JDA facility. All fish were frozen for analysis.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentatus*).
- B. Origin – Wild.
- C. Length –
- D. Marks and tags – None.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass –
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Unknown
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – Tribal collection staffs are reviewing all trapping, transport, and holding protocols to determine what, if any, preventative measures. Adults will be picked up daily. Temporarily limiting use of holding sites.
