

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 13TDA08 MFR – Lamprey Mortalities in The Dalles Dam East Fishway Count Station Traps

Weekly reports are provided by tribes for lamprey trapping results from the east count station. It was noticed that 1 lamprey mortality was found inside traps on 2 separate occasions (6/18 and 6/24). Upon further inquiry, tribal lamprey collectors brought mortalities to USFWS for analysis.

- A. Species – Pacific Lamprey
- B. Origin – unknown
- C. Length – approximate 18” lamprey
- D. Marks and tags – none.
- E. Marks and Injuries found on carcass – None
- F. Cause and Time of Death – Analysis in progress.
- G. Future and Preventative Measures – This coincides with a mortality that was raked from the downstream east count station picket leads, within 20’ of these traps (14TDA07). Collaborative efforts are being made to determine cause and possible correction (if any)
