Dear Mr. James and Mr. Jackson:

This is in response to your April 10, 2014 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam (BON) from May through September for the purpose of collecting up to 254 adult Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentata*) from BON, as part of the on-going project to restore lamprey to the tribes' 'ceded waters. This project is funded by the Bonneville Power Administration and managed by the CTUIR.

Please note, NOAA Fisheries and University of Idaho will be responsible for collecting lamprey and distributing lamprey not needed for research. Please coordinate with BON when planning your location for traps off the face of the dam. Locations will need to be coordinated with FPOM as well.


With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state, or tribal permits. **No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Mr. Andy Traylor and Ms. Tammy Mackey.**

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Mr. Andy Traylor, 541-374-4020. You will need to provide a Project impact statement, activity hazard analysis, copies of permits, and a personnel list. Please send electronic copies of these documents to Mr. Traylor, Andrew.W.Traylor@usace.army.mil and to Ms. Tammy Mackey, tammy.m.mackey@usace.army.mil.

Please remain in contact with Mr. Traylor throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations.
