## GENERAL CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATION OF THIS PERMIT:

- 1. This permit cannot be used in lieu of any permit required by federal law or regulation. Permission to sample in areas where federally protected fish may occur is contingent upon the permittee obtaining necessary authorization from the federal agency and acting in accordance with the conditions established by the federal government.
