

**Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation
Department of Natural Resources—Fisheries Program
Pacific Lamprey Research and Restoration Project**

PROJECT WORK PLAN

A key component to restoring lampreys to the Umatilla River as outlined in our approved restoration plan titled, *Restoration Plan for Pacific Lampreys (Lampetra tridentata) in the Umatilla River, Oregon*, is to collect adults for outplanting in the Umatilla River Basin. CTUIR proposes to collect up to 282 adult Pacific lamprey from behind the picket leads using pot traps, in the SMF facility (fall back adults) and in the new lamprey trap in the South fishway. CTUIR staff would come to John Day Dam and deploy pot traps in the North fishway behind the picket leads and deploy the trap box at the new lamprey trap in the South fishway in an attempt to collect upmigrating adult Pacific lampreys. Trap placement was chosen to avoid contact with any migrating salmonids. Traps would be checked daily. Trapped lampreys would be transported to a waiting 300 gallon holding tank supplied with oxygen and transported to one of our adult lamprey holding facilities, either South Fork Walla Walla or Minthorn Springs or held at the SMF lamprey tanks until transfer to our facilities. CTUIR anticipates collection to continue until we reach our yearly target of up to 282 adults. The USACOE's FPOM group approved this activity in June 2010-2013 and we request approval for 2014. CTUIR would begin trapping in June and likely finish in October or when target is reached. CTUIR has already had initial coordinated with Tammy Mackey and Miro Zyndol regarding this work. CTUIR would work with other tribes to help facilitate their perspective collections as well.

PROJECT IMPACT STATEMENT

CTUIR has no anticipated impacts to the existing project activities. Measures will be taken to assure project safety. Latex gloves will be used when deploying and checking traps to minimize human smell in the fishways.
