Dear Mr. Martinson:

This is in response to your February 3, 2014 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam's Juvenile Monitoring Facility (JMF) for the purposes of implementing the Smolt Monitoring Program. In addition to collecting and monitoring juvenile salmonids, as part of the Smolt Monitoring Program, you may also be collecting and holding fish for other researchers. Collecting and holding for others may only be conducted if those researchers have submitted their paperwork and received approval to access Bonneville Dam.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state permits. **No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Mr. Andy Traylor and Ms. Tammy Mackey.**



You will need to provide a Project impact statement, job hazard analysis, copies of permits, and a personnel list. Please remain in contact with Mr. Traylor throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations.
