This is in response to your April 10, 2015 letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Dam's Adult Fish Facility (AFF) in order to trap and hold lamprey for the purpose of supporting member tribes' efforts to restore Pacific Lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentata*) to the Columbia River Basin as part of The Tribal Pacific Lamprey Restoration Plan (TPLRP). It is understood that you will be responsible for the setting and checking of mechanical traps and for safely holding trapped adult lamprey at the AFF until member tribe staff transport lamprey adults to their respective ceded areas.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state, or tribal permits. No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Ms. Ida Royer and Ms. Tammy Mackey.
