Dear Ms. Porter:

This letter is in response to your May 14, 2020 letter requesting access to the John Day Project for the purpose of collecting and holding (up to 467) adult Pacific Lamprey for translocation. Fish may not be held at the John Day facility for longer than 48 hours, and the safety of these fish will be the collecting party's responsibility.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA, state and tribal permits.

No work may begin until valid and current permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required are on file with Michael Lotspeich and Erin Kovalchuk.

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, access to the John Day Lock and Dam may be limited. Additionally, there might be a delay in responding to your requests. Please contact Michael Lotspeich at least twenty four hours prior to your arrival at 541-506-7861. You will need to provide a project impact statement, job hazard analysis, copies of permits, and a personnel list. Please remain in contact with Michael Lotspeich throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working in the area, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations.
