Dear Mr. Whiteaker:

This is in response to your February 20, 2020, letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Project, including the Adult Fish Facility (AFF), for the purpose of sampling adult chinook, sockeye, and steelhead. This is a continuation of annual sampling activities. Sampling is expected to occur one to five days a week beginning in mid-March and continuing through the end of October. As you know, you will be required to follow all protocols found in the current Fish Passage Plan (FPP) Appendix G- AFF protocols for Bonneville Dam. In addition, you will need to comply with all reporting requirements found in the current FPP section BON 3.3.3.

You are also requesting access for the purpose of continuing annual sea lion hazing activities. It is understood those details will be submitted with the requests from WDFW and ODFW.

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Mr. Andrew Derugin, 541-374-43879. Please remain in contact with Mr. Derugin throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations
