Dear Mr. Whiteaker:

This is in response to your February 19, 2021, letter requesting approval for access to Bonneville Project for two projects. The first is annual adult salmonid sampling in the Adult Fish Facility (AFF). The second is boat-based non-lethal hazing, tracking, enumeration, and removal activities of Sea Lions in the Bonneville Dam BRZ. Both are continuation of annual activities.

AFF sampling is expected to occur one to five days a week beginning 01 April and continuing through the end of October 2021. As you know, you will be required to follow all protocols found in the current Fish Passage Plan (FPP) Appendix G- AFF protocols for Bonneville Dam. In addition, you will need to comply with all reporting requirements found in the current FPP section BON 3.3.3.

Sea Lion related work is understood to be part of a cooperative project with state agencies, with ODFW submitting the official Request Package. You may assist Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife and Oregon Dept. of Fish and Wildlife with tagging activities.

Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Mr. Andrew Derugin, 541-374-43879. Please remain in contact with Mr. Derugin throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations
